On October 8, 2022, Maryland & Delaware Railroad No. 1203, an Alco-GE RS3m, was the motive power for the Hurlock [MD] Fall Festival trains. The locomotive was built in March 1952 with serial number 79670 and has had multiple owners. Normally held on the first Saturday of October, this year's festival was delayed a week by inclement weather. Passengers rode in two coaches owned by the Town of Hurlock and members of the Wilmington Chapter, NRHS, served as car hosts.
