New Power For The Crescent



Amtrak's Crescent has been reequipped with new Siemens ALC-42 Long Distance locomotives, commonly known as "Chargers." These new locomotives are powered by a Cummins 16-cylinder 4-stroke high speed diesel engine, which meets EPA's more stringent Tier-4 emissions standards that took effect in 2015. Like its GE counterparts, the ALC-42 features a streamlined carbody and is also equipped with a 4,200-horsepower engine.
