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Restoration Begins on the Huron

We are still researching information on this car, but current records indicate it was built as Wheeling and Lake Erie Coach 021 in 1888, rebuilt as Parlor 045 in 1901, then transformed into the private car *Huron* in 1908. The car was lengthened in 1912 and renamed the *Wandle* in 1915. It received a steel underframe and renamed the *Cleveland* in 1924. It was lengthened again in 1927 before being transferred to the Nickel Plate Road.
