David Saunders writes, “Engine #1755 is named the *City of Salisbury*. Its number corresponds to the date of the founding of Salisbury. Other NCDOT locomotives are named and so numbered for various other cities served on the Piedmonts’ route. Thus, a relatively small number of locomotives have ended up with 4-digit numbers that are not necessarily sequential.

“Here’s a shot of Piedmont #77 arriving at Cary, last Sunday afternoon (11/24/2024). I took the photo as a half train/half nature photo, by getting both the pilot and the holly tree in the frame. It was a bit of a trick to time the shot just right, since the train had not yet come to a full stop.
