On Saturday, November 4, the Delaware Coast Line Railroad made a special run from Georgetown, DE, to Lewes, DE, to collect toys for the US Marine Corps Reserve's Toys for Tots program. DCLR 182, an MLW RS-18 built in November 1959, pulled caboose No. 1982, recently refurbished and adorned with the emblems of the branches of the military as well as the logo of the railroad itself and carrying guests for the occasion.
