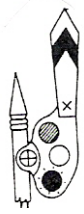

## **Buckingham Branch Railroad Comes to Norfolk**

Last month's HG cover featured Bay Coast Railroad No. 400, an EMD GP15-1 which was being used by a contracted Buckingham Branch Railroad crew in the wake of the sudden shutdown of the BCR. Now the BB has moved its No. 8, an EMD GP16, to its new Norfolk Division to pick up where the BCR left off. No. 8 was built in February 1951 as a GP7 numbered 135 for the Atlantic Coast Line with frame number 5099-3. Later it was rebuilt as a GP16 and renumbered CSX 1819 before coming to the BB.
