NS Closing Roanoke Shop

Norfolk Southern will soon close its historic Locomotive Shop in Roanoke, VA, and consolidate all remaining locomotive work at its Juniata Shop in Altoona, PA. The Roanoke Shop dates back to 1883 as the Norfolk & Western's Roanoke Machine Works. Additionally, NS will close the Roanoke Distribution Center supporting the shop as well as other mechanical department facilities across the railway. Read about it in this High Green!
