A pair of Southern Railway FP7s lead the *Dixie Limited* excursion through Burkeville, VA on the branch line between Richmond and Keysville, VA on August 7, 1982. This trip was sponsored by the Old Dominion Chapter NRHS and departed from the chapter's ex-Southern Railway's Hull Street station in Richmond. At Keysville the passengers were treated to live country music and an old-fashioned southern barbeque. This line was originally the Richmond & Danville Railroad's main line, completed in 1856 and absorbed into Southern Railway in 1894.
